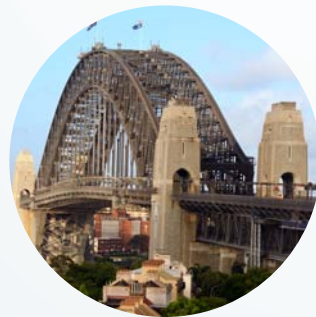
Homestay Holiday in Sydney

Dates : 27 July – 3 August, 2014 (could be changed by 1 -2 days)

Stay at : Volunteer families in Sydney

Air travel by : JAL or Qantas

Cost : Free (what is included in the itinerary. Refer to page 2 for details)

Eligible applicants : Those aged 10-18 with victim certificate of the great earthquake disaster of east Japan

Tour guide : An adult will accompany the group from Japan

Planned activities : Sightseeing of major Sydney sites (Bondi Beach, Opera House, Harbour Bridge, Darling Harbour, Circular Quay, etc), a visit to a local school, an experience of Aboriginal rituals, Taronga Zoo, etc

Application details and conditions

This respite holiday project is organised by JCS Rainbow Project (the Project) with assistance Kinki Nippon Tourist KK (KNT) and the participants will accept the conditions set by the Project.

The costs covered by the Project are:

The return airfare and transfer coaches, activities. Full board homestay, a tour guide

The costs not covered by the Project are:

Transfer between home and the meeting point in Japan. Costs relating to activities not included in the itinerary.

Eligibility

10 students and pupils who had suffered from the great earthquake disaster of east Japan in March 2011. If more than 10 applications are received, the Project will use its discretion to select the 10 participants. Preference will be given to those with victim certificates of severe grade.

Selection process

- 1 Fill in the application form and send in to the address below no later than 28 February 2014. A copy of victim certificate and an essay must be attached.
The essay topic : what I learned from the Disaster, ideas for the future. Up to around 800 letters.
- 2 Successful applicants will be notified by email. (please contact below if you have questions)

Application period

November 2013 - 28 February 2014

If we can accept more than 10, we may change the maximum number of participants without notice.
